

THE LATEST NUMBERS: NEW TARIFFS HITTING FLORIDA ECONOMY HARD

- · According to the most recent data, Florida businesses paid \$110 million in tariffs on products subject to Trump Administration tariffs in December. That is about 9 times the tariffs paid on those same products in December 2017.
- · Since new tariffs were imposed, Florida businesses have paid an extra \$388 million in import tariffs.
- · Since the trade war began, Florida exports have faced \$98 million in new retaliatory tariffs from our trading partners, including \$15 million in December. These tariffs make Florida less competitive. <u>In</u> December, Florida exports subject to retaliation dropped by 26%.
