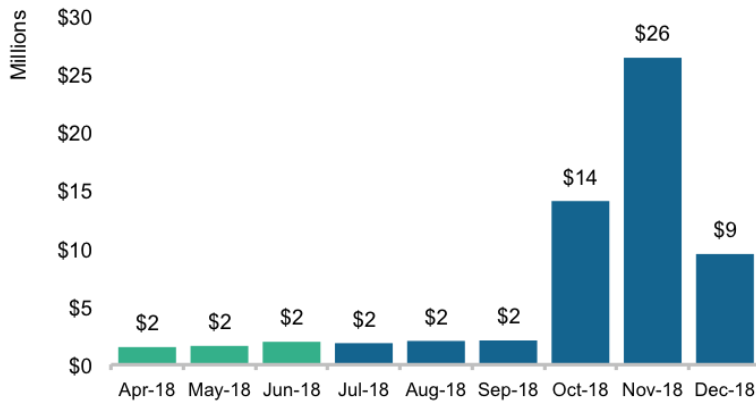

### THE LATEST NUMBERS: NEW TARIFFS HITTING IDAHO ECONOMY HARD

- According to the most recent data, Idaho businesses paid \$8.5 million in tariffs on products subject to Trump Administration tariffs in December. That is about 36 times the tariffs paid on those same products in December 2017.
- Since new tariffs were imposed, Idaho businesses have paid an extra \$47 million in import tariffs.
- Since the trade war began, Idaho exports have faced \$13 million in new retaliatory tariffs from our trading partners, including \$2.7 million in December. These tariffs make Idaho less competitive. In December, Idaho exports subject to retaliation dropped by 15%.

President Trump should successfully negotiate with our trading partners and end these costly and harmful tariffs. Idaho jobs are on the line.
